



Event Regulations Red Bull Hangar-7 SUNSET

Admission & Entry

Entry is only permitted with a valid, personalized ticket and entry wristband, for persons aged 21 and over.
ID check at check-in.

Payment terms: Cashless only!

Drugs, Alcohol & Prohibited Items

Heavily intoxicated persons or persons under the influence of drugs may be refused entry or asked to leave. The sale of drugs is strictly prohibited and will result in immediate expulsion and, if necessary, prosecution.
The following are specifically prohibited: weapons and weapon-like objects, pyrotechnics, pepper spray, glass bottles, as well as bringing your own food and drinks.
Bag and personal checks at entry are possible.

Smoking

A general smoking ban applies in Red Bull Hangar-7.
Smoking (including e-cigarettes) is only permitted in designated smoking areas (Hangar-7 Outdoor Lounge).

Sanitary Facilities

Only the toilets in the basement are to be used for sanitary purposes.

Photo & Video Recordings

Filming and photography are permitted exclusively for private purposes.
Any direct or indirect commercial use of the recordings requires prior written approval from Red Bull Hangar-7.

Safety & Emergencies

Escape routes and emergency exits must remain clear at all times and may only be used in case of emergency. Safety barriers must be observed. Touching, climbing, or sitting on exhibits, the steel structure, or other facilities is not permitted.
Instructions from Hangar-7 supervisory staff must be followed.

Liability & Lost Property

Red Bull Hangar-7 assumes no liability for personal items that are lost or damaged.
Found items should be handed in at Lost & Found.

Damages & Visitor Liability

Visitors are liable for all damages they intentionally or negligently cause to the building, exhibits, or other facilities of Red Bull Hangar-7 or Salzburg Airport. Red Bull Hangar-7 reserves the right to assert claims for damages and to issue bans from the premises in the event of serious or repeated violations.

Visitors are subject to the civil airport usage conditions of Salzburg Airport as well as EU Regulation (EC) 300/2008 (Security in Civil Aviation) in its latest version.
